Giving Options!

- 3) Online giving is an option through our church website at livinglifereformed.churchcenter.com/giving. This is a secure site with an easy set-up process.
- 4) "Text to Give": Text any dollar amount (example: \$20) to "84321" to give. A quick set-up process will be needed to tie your mobile phone to LLRC, your donation account (for year-end giving statements), and a payment source. After the initial setup, giving is as easy as sending a text message!
