Dear Church Family,

Outraged. This was the sentiment of a woman at Sam's Club. After Christmas, I was returning an unneeded Christmas gift. While waiting in line, I witnessed a woman go from calm to cruel in a matter of seconds. What was the cause of the offense? She would need to return a broken item at the counter. Then proceeded to pick out a replacement and checkout as she usually would. She criticized this employee for the inconvenience and incompetence of the organization.

When it was my time to approach the counter, I said, "I am sorry. I'm not sure what's going on beneath the surface of that woman, but that was a first-world problem."

My friend, pastor, and author, Dr. Michael Frisina, told me, "Unless you're being shot at, cold, drenched, and without resources, you're having a good day." As a former Army Officer, he would know the truth of this statement.

So why do so many people in America and around the world, including Christians, have their joy robbed by the slightest of inconveniences? The answer is found in 2 Corinthians 2:14-16.

Paul writes, "Therefore, we do not give up. Even though our outer person is being destroyed, our inner person is being renewed day by day. For our momentary light affliction is producing for us an absolutely incomparable eternal weight of glory. So we do not focus on what is seen but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal" (CSB).

Paul was no denier of hardship. He knew it well. He didn't dismiss it or trivialize it. Instead, he walked through it while keeping his focus on eternity with Christ. That is the problem. We focus on the problem and not the promise. We dwell on the trial and not the triumph. We embrace the temporary and not the eternal.

Paul went from earthly influence and affluence to heavenly purpose and wealth.

When I look at 2 Corinthians 2, I'm reminded that many of us today face various seasons of life. Some are financially flush but live as spiritually bankrupt. Some are troubled but resourced. Some are blessed but burned out. The question is, how should we respond to each event and season? Focused on the eternal weight of glory.

A job promotion pales in comparison to a passport to paradise. A full savings account is diminished by a room in the house of God. Trials of various kinds are light compared to the "absolutely comparable eternal weight of glory." So today, live with eternity in mind.

Let us "seek the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God" (Col. 3:1). May we fix our "hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ" (1 Peter 3:13). It's my prayer to live on purpose. You were saved for more than what this world offers or threatens. Live with eternity in mind. Live generously. Live intentionally. Why? Because according to 1 Corinthians 3:21, "Everything is yours."
